

RESOLUTION No. 470-19

A RESOLUTION ADDING TWO NATIVE TREES TO THE SMALL TREE LIST OF DESIRABLE TREES FOR PLANTING ALONG STREETS AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 337-12

WHEREAS, On November 13, 2012 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 337-12 approving a list of trees desirable for planting along streets to help minimize damage to streets and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Donald Municipal Code Chapter 93 sets forth the regulations maintenance, and requirements for public trees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Donald Municipal Code 93.03 designates the Planning Commission as the authority for all tree related matters within the city, and serves in lieu of a designated Tree Board as recognized by the State Department of Forestry and the National Arbor Day Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Donald Municipal Code 93.04 requires the development and maintenance of a list of desirable trees for planting along streets in three size classes based on mature height; as well a list of trees not suitable for planting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the Planning Commission encourage native plantings as set forth in the Donald Development Code, Section 2.306 Site and Landscaping Design because they require less water and provide habitats for local birds and other species; and

WHEREAS, a Planning Commissioner researched and consulted local government arborists and nearby non-profit associations in preparation to propose to the Planning Commission native trees to the small public tree list; and

WHEREAS, On February 21, 2019 the Planning Commission voted 6-0-0 recommending to the City Council to add two native trees to the Rhamnus Purshiana (Cascara) and Corylus Cornuta (Hazelnut) trees to the small tree public tree list.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Donald a list of desirable trees for planting along streets.

Section 1: The City of Donald’s list of trees for planting along streets in three size classes based on mature height shall be:

Section 2: All other trees are prohibited from installation within the public rights-of-way as they cause one or more of the following problems (1) their roots damage sewer and/or water lines or pavement; (2) they are particularly subject to disease or insects; and (3) they cause visibility problems along streets or intersections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

By the Donald City Council the additional native plant selections are added to the small tree list of desirable trees for planting along streets.
