RESOLUTION No. 569-23

A RESOLUTION AMENDING WATER, SEWER, PARK, STORMWATER AND TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT CHARGE FEES.

WHEREAS, the Donald City Council adopted Ordinance No. 108-97, creating Donald Municipal Code Section 152 *Financing Public Improvements* establishing system development charges and fees for water and sewer and later updated by acceptance of Ordinance No. 166-2016; and,

WHEREAS, the Donald City Council on May 10, 2016 approved Resolution No. 403-16 establishing system development charges and fees for transportation, park and storm sewer systems; and,

WHEREAS, the Donald City Council on July 13, 2021 approved Resolution No. 534-21, which modified the system development charges and methodology and improvement plans for the water, sewer, transportation, park and storm sewer systems and set fees for all system development funds; and,

WHEREAS, a change in the amount of a reimbursement fee or an improvement fee is not a modification of the system development charge methodology if the change is based on the requirements set forth in ORS 223.304(8)(b); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 223.304(8)(b)(B) the City of Donald uses the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index; and,

WHEREAS, for January 2023 the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index was 13,175.03 which is an increase of 4.93% from the ENR CCI of 12,555.55 from January 2022, attached as Exhibit B.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DONALD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the fees listed in Exhibit A are hereby adopted.

Section 2. The ENR CCI is attached and incorporated as Exhibit B demonstrating the 4.93% increase, effective July 1, 2023.




The MCI stayed flat last month, while the annual escalation rate increased 16%.
