

RESOLUTION No. 612-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DONALD TO JOIN THE NORTH MARION TOURISM COLLABORATIVE.

WHEREAS, tourism plays an important role in supporting local businesses, economic development, and community vitality within the City of Donald; and

WHEREAS, the North Marion Tourism Collaborative (“NMTC”) is a regional partnership focused on promoting tourism, marketing local attractions, coordinating events, and enhancing visitor experiences within North Marion County; and

WHEREAS, participation in the NMTC provides opportunities for regional collaboration, shared marketing resources, and coordinated economic development strategies that benefit Donald and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, membership in the NMTC will allow the City of Donald to participate in tourism planning efforts, regional promotion initiatives, and grant and funding opportunities related to tourism and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that joining the North Marion Tourism Collaborative is in the best interest of the community and supports the City’s long-term economic and community development goals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DONALD, OREGON:

Section 1. Authorization to Join

The City Council hereby authorizes the City of Donald to become a member of the North Marion Tourism Collaborative.

Section 2. Designation of Representative

The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to serve as the City’s representative to the North Marion Tourism Collaborative and to participate in meetings, planning activities, and related initiatives.

Section 3. Execution of Agreements

The City Manager is authorized to execute any membership agreements, participation forms, or related documents necessary to effectuate the City's participation in the North Marion Tourism Collaborative, subject to applicable budgetary constraints and City policies.

Section 4. Financial Participation

Any membership fees, dues, or financial contributions associated with participation in the North Marion Tourism Collaborative shall be communicated to the City Council through the annual budget process, as required.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
