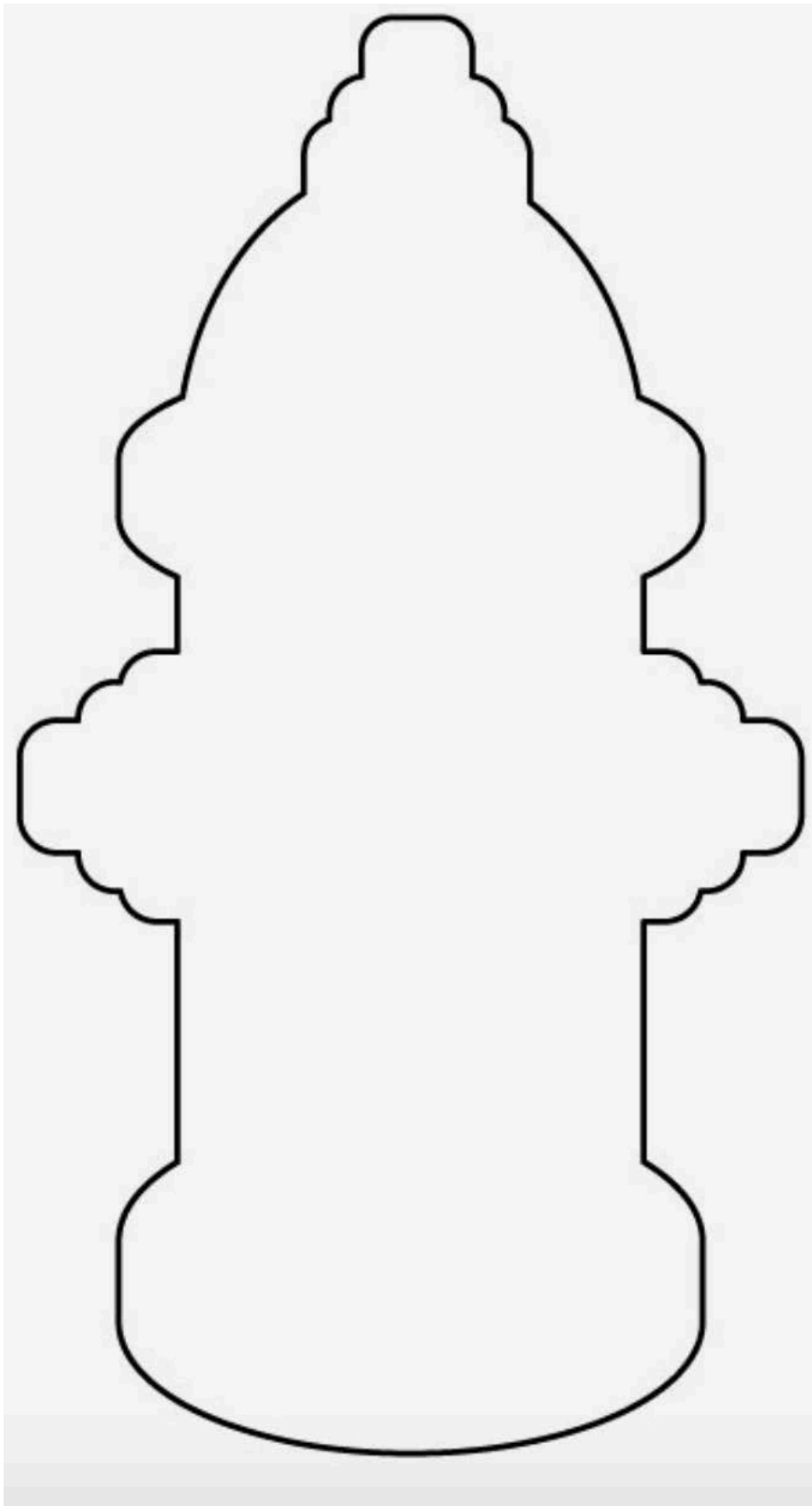

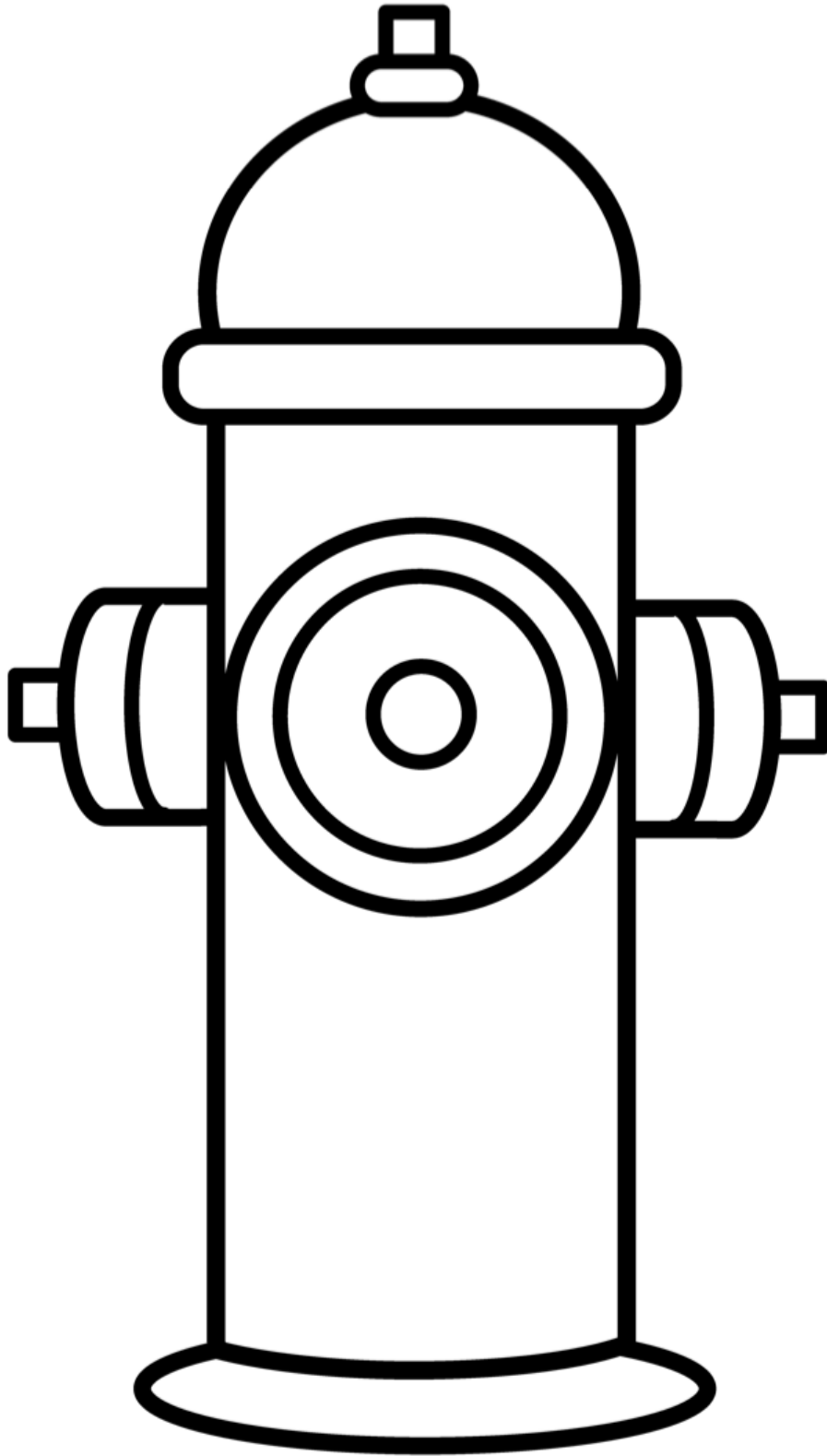
Fire Hydrant Painting Rules and Directions:

- All applications must be preapproved. Please complete the front and back of your design on the fire hydrant template provided.
- Designs must match the preapproved application. If you'd like to make changes, please contact Eric Underwood at citymanager@donaldoregon.gov
- Designs cannot have the following: drugs, alcohol, violence, political references (Americana is ok!), profanity, or crude scenes, or trademarked logos. No text on the design please, except for a 3" x 3" portion for the artist's signature. Hydrants must remain visible and not blend into the surroundings.
- **Please include a golden hazelnut** somewhere on your design! Residents and visitor will have fun hunting for the hazelnuts on the different hydrants. A stencil and a pot of gold paint will be provided for the hazelnut.
- Applicants will be provided with oil-based acrylic enamel paint in the following colors: black, white, red, green, yellow and blue, and a set of brushes. Other colors may be mixed from this set of paints. Please don't use any other type of paint on the hydrant.
- You will be responsible for maintaining the fire hydrant for two years.
- Public Works reserves the right to repaint the hydrant at any time.
- Please do not paint the reflector at the bottom of the hydrant.
- Please do not attach anything to the hydrant.
- Keep the space around the hydrant clean and paint free. A drop cloth will be provided to wrap around the hydrant while you are working. Please remove your paint and brushes when not working on the hydrant.
- Hydrant caps must be able to open after the paint dries. Please do not let paint seep into the hydrant threads.
- You may only paint the hydrant assigned to you.
- **All hydrants must be painted by August 31st, 2022**
- All hydrants will be featured on a local map for a fun scavenger hunt. Please let us know if you do not want your name associated with the hydrant you painted.

Thank you so much for taking time to bring fun to the City of Donald! The painted hydrants are a treat for residents and visitors of all ages.
