Should the Speed Limit Change on the City's Local Roads?

The City Council is discussing reducing the speed limits on the city-maintained streets. Currently the speed limit is 25mph. The City does not have the authority to set the speed limit on Butteville Road, Main Street or any of the privately-operated communities (anyone who belongs to a Home Owner's Association). Please answer the following questions to help guide the Council through their decision process. Survey is due Monday, August 26, 2019. The Council will review the survey's results at their September 10th meeting.
