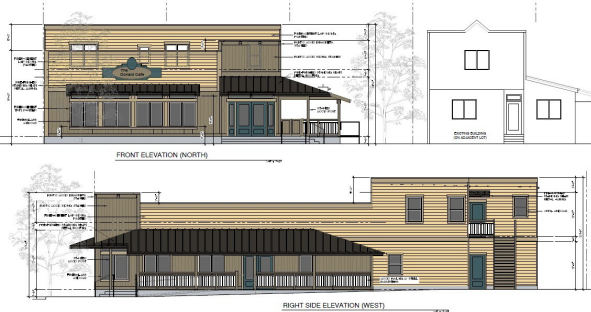

DONALD CAFÉ IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION



The new and improved Donald Café is under construction and expected to be completed the summer of 2026. Owners Darren & Joan Monen, also owners of the Wild Hare Restaurants in Canby and Oregon City, have roots in the Donald community. They feel like Donald chose them for the location of their third restaurant. Joan’s mom grew up on Olmstead Rd and Darren and Joan lived in Donald from 1992-1995 as they were starting their lives together. They happened to hear that the Donald Café property was for sale in November of 2020 and the purchase of the property and name from the former owner was finalized in May of 2021. They decided to demolish the old Donald Café and replace it with a new building, constructed by Darren’s company, Monen Construction Remodeling & Design Inc, so that the Café can be housed in a space that will be suitable for the next 20 years as the Donald Café’ evolves. The name will stay the same and Joan plans to start small, listen, learn and grow. The Café will focus on serving breakfast and lunch, likely Wednesday through Sundays. She said that her businesses are always involved in the community and provide training and mentorship for employees as many are youth who are being hired for their first jobs. Future plans include construction of the mercantile building on the property next door to the Donald Café.

BURN SEASON INFORMATION FROM AURORA FIRE

Burn season is tentatively set to begin October 15th, 2025 but the actual start date may be delayed depending on weather conditions. Before burning yard debris, please call the **Burn Information Line at 1-877-982-0011** to confirm whether burning is allowed that day. Remember to only burn natural yard debris from your property, keep your pile small and manageable, clear vegetation and combustibles around the burn area, have water and tools ready, and never leave your fire unattended until it is fully extinguished. Prohibited materials such as plastics, garbage, treated lumber, and construction debris may not be burned. **If you observe illegal or unsafe burning, or have smoke complaints, you may contact the Oregon DEQ at 1-888-997-7888.**



CITY COUNCIL UPDATE



At the September 9 City Council meeting, the Council unanimously approved Business Licenses for Eichler Construction Group, Inc. and Fred Eichler Construction. Both businesses will be located at 21100 Butteville Rd NE. They also unanimously approved a Business License for Capital Lumber at 10590 Donald Rd NE. In other new business, they approved Resolution 605-25 which declared a City owned tractor no longer in use as surplus, allowing it to be sold.
