Mayors bring ideas, energy and wisdom together to make their communities a better place. In Donald, the Mayor gets to cast a vote on all decisions before the City Council. The Mayor serves a two-year term. There are six councilors in Donald and they are elected every four years. Donald’s mayor and councilors are all volunteer positions.

Generally, they are responsible for the budget management, department oversight, internal affairs and external relations.
