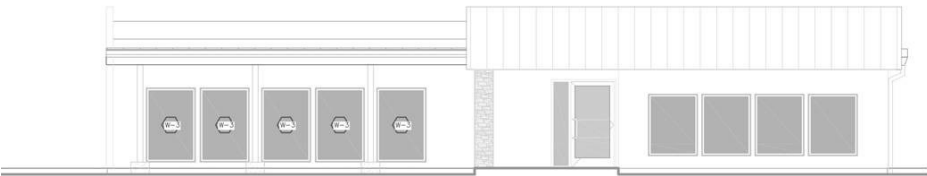

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE:
10741 MAIN ST NE



G Cam Ltd, a construction and homebuilding company owned by Georgi and Toni Cam, is remodeling the former church building at 10741 Main Street NE in Donald. They are hoping to complete the remodeling process by the end of the cal-

endar year and plan to move their company into the remodeled of-
fice space from its current location in Canby. They decided to move
the company to Donald because of the easy freeway access and the
fact that it is close to their home. Most of the employees of the com-
pany are working out in the field on construction projects but there
will likely be three people working in the office space full time. The
old building is getting a facelift and will remain a useful structure in
the City of Donald for many years to come.



The vacant lots to the west of the building are also owned by G
Cam Ltd. When they have funding, they would also like to develop
those lots, with an expected timeline of about three years before
developing plans with construction hopefully taking place in 2030
or 2031. The thought is to have retail space on the main level and
possibly residential space on the second floor for mixed use.

CASE CX60 TRACTOR



The City’s 1999 Case IH CX60 tractor is an agricultural tractor from the CX Series. It is known for its efficient 60 hp Perkins 3-cylinder diesel engine. The CX60 was designed for general farm use and can



be used as a utility tractor with a front loader attachment. The tractor is in good condition and runs very well. It has very low running hours: only 253.2.

The City Council recently passed Resolution 605-25 declaring the tractor as surplus property, which authorized the sale, since it is no longer needed to perform work for the City of Donald. CITY COUNCIL PASSES RES. 606-25 ESTABLISHING NIMS AS STANDARD FOR EMERGENCY MGMT.
The City is developing an emergency operations plan to better respond in the times of emergency and NIMS has recently been incorporated as part of that process. The National Incident Management System (NIMS) guides all levels of government, nongovernmental organizations, and the private sector to work together to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to and recover from incidents and emergencies. The City Council’s action of passing Resolution 606-25, adopting NIMS as the standard, officially documents the City’s commitment to protecting the community and coordinating with partnering agencies in emergency response.
